Primary Care Nurse Practitioners at BQWCHC act as most responsible provider in consultation with a BQWCHC primary care physician.

- Clinical services – performs assessments, diagnosis, treatments, health education / counselling and other medical functions based on appropriate standards of practice
- Continuity of Care – conducts same-day access appointments, home visits as required and provides on call support
- Equity & client-centred approach – works with clients, and engages with other services, in a manner that is mindful of the whole person/community within a social context and impacted by social determinants of health
- Quality Improvement – participates in continuous quality improvement work
- Teamwork – works collaboratively as a member of the interdisciplinary team
- Administrative – contributes to the development, implementation and evaluation of clinical protocols and medical directives and other process improvements
- Mentoring – supports and evaluates students, medical residents and others learners

QUALIFICATIONS

- RN (EC) license to practice from College of Nurses of Ontario
- Experienced as a Nurse Practitioner, with preference to those with experience in primary health care or in a community setting
- Experience working effectively with communities and individuals who face barriers accessing health care and other supports; with a focus on mental health challenges and problematic substance use preferred
- Demonstrated problem-solving, organizational and interpersonal skills with an ability to work effectively and respectfully in a collaborative, interdisciplinary team environment
- Understanding of and experience utilizing a trauma-informed approach preferred
- Work hours include one evening shift per week and participation in a “on call” roster
