BQWCHC opened in 2010 and is one of 73 community health centres in Ontario. We boast a range of services and initiatives designed to respond to the health needs of our clients and local community. With a health equity focus we emphasize services to populations who face barriers to accessing health services and who have lower health outcome. The organization is responsible for the administrative and operational infrastructure. BQWCHC is also the lead agency for the Quinte Health Link. We offer a competitive benefits package including pension plan.
